**Day 1 July 1, Sunday: Depart for Italy**

This afternoon, depart New York's JFK International Airport on our overseas journey to Palermo via Rome. Complimentary dinner, breakfast and beverages will be served on the flight. (D,B)

**Day 2 July 2, Monday: Arrive in Palermo, Sicily**

Early morning, arrive at Rome's Leonardo da Vinci Airport and connect to our Alitalia flight to Palermo, Sicily. Go through Passport Control, claim our luggage and a Peter's Way tour manager will meet us as we exit Customs. Board our private tour bus and we will be on our way to Palermo for an orientation tour. Independent lunch. Visit the Palazzo dei Normanni, once the seat of the Kings of Sicily during the Norman domination. Inside are the Cappella Palatina and La Sala di Re Ruggiero, glittering chambers encrusted with mosaics of eastern influence. Continue to the Church of St. John of the Hermits (*San Giovanni degli Eremiti*), a lovely Arab-Norman church with picturesque red domes and a cloister with elegantly wrought columns and a beautiful tropical garden. End our day with **Mass at Santa Maria Assunta Cathedral**. After Mass, we will have a brief guided tour the Cathedral. Return to the hotel.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Palermo. (D)

**Day 3 July 3, Tuesday: Santa Rosalia Shrine | Monreale | Cefalu**

Breakfast at hotel. Begin our day with **Mass at the Cave Church of Santa Rosalia**, patron saint of Palermo. Visit the Sanctuary that serves as the burial place and shrine to Santa Rosalia, who died in the cave in the 12th century, and appeared a few centuries later to residents of Palermo. Then, we will leave on an excursion to Monreale, site of the famous *Cattedrale di Santa Maria la Nuova*, built by King William II between 1172 and 1176. The most important Norman church in Sicily, the Cathedral houses extraordinary medieval artwork. The interior walls are almost entirely covered with mosaic scenes from the Old and New Testaments. One of the most stunning depictions is the Christ Pantocrator. After independent lunch, continue to Cefalu on the northern coast of Sicily, on the Tyrrhenian Sea. Visit Cefalù Cathedral, a 12th century fortress-like structure with elaborate Byzantine mosaics and soaring twin towers. Free time in Cefalu. Return to Palermo early evening.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Palermo. (B,D)

**Day 4 July 4, Wednesday: Piazza Armerina | Syracuse**

Buffet breakfast at hotel. Today we will explore Piazza Armerina, a historic town nestled into the heart of Sicily. There are many wonderful buildings to see including the 18th century Duomo, which dominates the town standing majestically on top of a hill. Independent lunch. Continue to Syracuse, where the Apostle Paul stayed for three days after he departed Malta en route to Rome (AA 28:11-13). In ancient times Syracuse was the western capital of Magna Graecia and one of the greatest cities in the world. Many buildings from this ancient period have survived. Most are in the "archaeological zone". We'll visit the Catacombs of John with its magnificent frescos and the crypt of Marziano, site of the first Christian Church on the Island. Visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Tears, a place of pilgrimage, prayer and recollection of a miracle, where Mary wept from a humble plaster plaque of the Immaculate Heart. Next, visit the Duomo and the church of Santa Lucia alla Badia. Inside the church there is a very famous painting by Carravaggio, *St. Lucia's Funeral*. St. Lucy is the patroness of Syracuse. We will **celebrate Mass at the Shrine of St. Lucy**. After Mass, check-in at hotel in Syracuse.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Syracuse. (B,D)

**Day 5 July 5, Thursday: Messina | Taormina**

Breakfast at hotel. This morning, we leave Syracuse and drive north to Messina. Upon arrival, visit the Cathedral of Messina (*Santa Maria Assunta*), dating back to the 12th century and thoroughly restored between 1919-1920 due to an earthquake. See some of the main monuments of the Cathedral, in order to appreciate almost one thousand years of art and faith. **Celebrate Mass in the Cathedral**. Independent lunch. After lunch, visit the Regional Museum with world-class works including two Caravaggio masterpieces, the *Adoration of the Shepherds* and the *Resurrection of Lazarus*, as well as works of other painters showing the Caravaggio influence. After our visit we continue to Taormina for hotel check-in.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Taormina. (B,D)

**Day 6 July 6, Friday: Naples | Pompeii | Sorrento**

Breakfast at hotel. After breakfast, we will be transferred to Catania Airport for the 11:35 am flight to Naples. Upon arrival in Naples, claim our luggage and board our private motor coach to visit Pompeii. Independent lunch en route. In Pompeii we will explore the incredibly well-preserved remains of this ancient Roman town, where all life was suddenly stopped by an eruption of Vesuvius in the year 79 A.D. **Celebrate Mass at the Franciscan Basilica of the Rosary in Pompeii**. Then, our coach will pass through orange and lemon gardens to Sant'Agata Sui Due Golfi, a charming resort on the Sorrento Peninsula with beautiful views of the Gulf of Naples and the Gulf of Salerno. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Seiano or Vico Equense. (B,D)

**Day 7 July 7, Saturday: Positano | Amalfi Towns**

Buffet breakfast at hotel. Today the group will travel by mini-buses along the Amalfi coast. Our first stop will be in Positano with its commanding view of the sea. Continue to the town of Amalfi to visit the Cathedral of St. Andrew the Apostle and the crypt where the saint's relics are kept in the central altar. **Celebrate Mass at the Cathedral**. Independent lunch in Amalfi Town. Then, continue along the coast to Ravello, said to be nearer to the sky than the sea. Pass through Minori, Maiori, Vietri Sul Mare and Salerno. Return to our hotel. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Seiano or Vico Equense. (B,D)

**Day 8 July 8, Sunday: Benevento**

Breakfast at hotel. After breakfast, we leave the Amalfi region to Benevento, the birthplace of St. Padre Pio. We will visit the house where St. Pio was born, Santa Ana Chapel where he was baptized, Santa Maria degli Angeli where he celebrated his first Mass, and Piana Romana where he received the invisible stigmata. **Celebrate Mass at Santa Maria degli Angeli**. Independent lunch. Continue to San Giovanni Rotondo for hotel check-in.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in San Giovanni Rotondo. (B,D)

**Day 9 July 9, Monday: San Giovanni Rotondo | Mont-St.-Angelo**

Breakfast at hotel. After breakfast, visit the Basilica of Our Lady of Grace. **Celebrate Mass at one of the Chapels**. After Mass, visit Padre Pio's cell, the old church where he received the stigmata, his confessional and the new Church of Our Lady of Grace. Time will be given for prayer, reflection and independent lunch. Our afternoon excursion to Mont-St.-Angelo will allow for a visit to the Grotto of St. Michael the Archangel. Popes and saints alike have all knelt in prayer at this grotto, seeking the protection of St. Michael. Return to San Giovanni Rotondo. Dinner and overnight at hotel in San Giovanni Rotondo. (B,D)

**Day 10 July 10, Tuesday: Lanciano | Rome**

Breakfast at hotel. This morning, we depart San Giovanni Rotondo for the Abruzzi region to visit Lanciano. Group lunch at a restaurant is included. After lunch, see the Eucharistic Miracle at the Church of St. Francis in Lanciano. Hear and reflect on the story about a priest-monk of the Order of St. Basil who suffered from recurrent doubts regarding transubstantiation. While celebrating Mass, he had just spoken the solemn words of Consecration when the host suddenly changed into a circle of flesh, and the wine was transformed into visible blood. **Celebrate Mass at the Shrine**. After Mass, continue to Rome stopping for independent dinner en route. Check in at hotel upon arrival in Rome. Overnight at hotel in Rome. (B,L)

**Day 11 July 11, Wednesday: Papal Basilicas of Rome | Imperial Rome | Farewell Dinner**

After early breakfast walk to St. Peter's Basilica to **celebrate Mass at the Tomb of St. Peter** (*subject to confirmation*). After Mass, we will have a brief explanation of the Basilica then continue to the Basilica of St. Mary Major. We will also visit the Cathedral of St. John Lateran, the first Christian church to be consecrated and home to the popes for many years prior to the present Vatican residence. For those who wish, go up the *Scala Sancta* on your knees as thousands of pilgrims do reverently meditating on the sufferings of Christ. Visit the Basilica of the Holy Cross in Jerusalem, which houses fragments of the true cross, and the Church of St. Peter in Chains to see the original chains in which St. Peter was brought captive to Rome. Continue to the ancient Roman Forum and the outside of the Coliseum for a brief explanation of its history. Our tour concludes at the Pantheon and then the lively Piazza Navona to see the church of St. Agnes and Bernini's fountain. **Our farewell dinner, this evening, will be at a restaurant in Rome**. Overnight at hotel in Rome. (B,D)

**Day 12 July 12, Thursday: Return to the USA**

After buffet breakfast, we will be transferred to Rome's Leonardo Da Vinci Airport for our return flight home. Arrive on the same day. (B)

Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

**PAYMENT:** Deposits and insurance payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order or credit card. **Participants who submit payments entirely by personal check will receive a \$100 per person discount.** Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to increase package price or reduce services accordingly should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If final payment is not received by the balance deadline, Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to cancel your reservation. If for any reason payment is received within 21 days of departure, a charge for express mailing of final documents will apply. A \$50.00 late payment fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank has returned a personal check, a \$25.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check or credit card.

**CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS:** From the time your deposit is received up to 130 days prior to departure, there is a \$250.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 129 to 100 days prior to departure, there is a \$350.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, there is a nonrefundable cancellation fee of 100% of all payments made per person including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments and any other costs incurred. Travel insurance is offered as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons such as illness or injury, please see TRAVEL INSURANCE. Travel insurance payments are nonrefundable upon receipt. Tour participation is nontransferable. Names cannot be transferred on reservations or airline tickets. Refund requests can only be honored when submitted in writing to Peter's Way Tours. All refund requests are subject to cancellation restrictions as set forth above. No refund will be made for any accommodations or services included in the tour that you do not use.

**LATE BOOKINGS:** A \$25.00 late fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for bookings received after the deposit deadline. All space is subject to availability and cannot be guaranteed past the deposit deadline noted on the brochure.

**TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:** All participants must have a valid passport. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months, subsequent to return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current requirements. It is solely the passenger's responsibility to ensure that all documents needed are completed, in good condition, and current. Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for lack of current and valid entry documents.

**AIR TRANSPORTATION:** Round trip from **JFK International Airport on Alitalia Airlines plus one-way domestic segments in Italy.** Flight itinerary and carrier are subject to changes. Departure taxes & fuel surcharges are estimated. They are determined solely by the airlines and are subject to increase prior to ticketing (*approximately 30 days prior to departure*).

**AIRLINE SEATING:** Under group airline reservations provide a block of seats for the group. **Individual requests for seating preferences can only be made at time of check-in.** Peter's Way cannot submit seating preferences as we cannot guarantee that any or all requests will be honored. If you require specific seating as a condition of your travel, it is suggested that you book your airfare individually and purchase the Land Only package. Upgrades to premium economy, business class, or first class may be available but oftentimes airlines will not allow the upgrades until time of ticketing (*approximately 30 days prior to departure*). Group reservations may not be accessible online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. Airline guidelines vary. Please contact our office for specific details.

**LAND ONLY PASSENGERS:** **Land Only packages do not include any portion of the group airfare. This includes any flights booked within the group itinerary.** All airline tickets will be your responsibility to book independently. A passenger choosing the Land Only portion of the package (**\$3,595.00, double occupancy**) must notify Peter's Way Tours, in writing, at least 100 days prior to departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package or who are deviating from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from hotel/airport. However, if you arrive at the same time or earlier than your group, you are welcome to join the group on the bus. It is recommended that you purchase your air transportation only after you have been notified that the group has materialized. If you purchase your own air transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel your package for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare or other arrangements booked independently.

**DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES:** Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with changes in itineraries. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure. Deviation fee will apply plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for more information.

**TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE:** Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels is also included.

**ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS:** Price per person is based on two persons sharing twin bedded rooms in hotels throughout your tour. Double bedded rooms for married couples are subject to availability and must be requested. Triple rooms may be requested but we discourage triple room accommodations because there is no discount for triple occupancy and rooms are usually twin or double bedded rooms with a rollaway bed added. Single rooms are limited but may be requested at booking. If confirmed, **an additional charge of \$795.00** will apply. While single rooms provide privacy, they are often smaller than twin bedded rooms and may be away from the group in hotels. We will make every effort to match you with a same gender roommate when we receive your enrollment, but we do not guarantee a roommate pairing. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or on tour), we must charge the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

**MEALS:** European breakfast daily, plus one lunch in Lanciano, and nine (9) dinners, including a **festive farewell dinner in Rome.** Beverages (coffee, tea, mineral water) are not included at set menu dinners.

**GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES:** Gratuities to the tour manager and driver are not included in the package price. For good work, we recommend 4,00 Euro per person per day for your tour manager; 2,00 Euro (per person per day for your bus driver; 1,50 Euro per person for a local guide when applicable). Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. Other gratuities are usually handled individually. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges at the hotels are included, it is customary to leave 1,00 Euro per person for your waiter following dinner at the hotel and 1,00 Euro per person per day for housekeeping.

**TRAVELER HEALTH ADVISORY:** All passengers must ensure that they are medically and physically fit for travel; and that such traveling will not endanger themselves or others as our pilgrimages entail a lot of walking, which may involve stairs, hills, cobblestone roads and uneven pavement.
